NRNA NCC Norway's inception was inspired by the vision of bringing Nepali communities in Norway together and connecting them with their roots and heritage. In 2005, NRNA's NCC was established in Norway, marking a pivotal moment in our history. This development allowed us to create a local platform for Nepali and Norwegian/foreign citizens of Nepali origin living in Norway, providing them with a sense of community and a shared purpose.

Objectives

The main objectives of NRNA NCC Norway are to create a common forum for Nepali and Norwegian/foreign citizens of Nepali origin living in Norway and help to the development of Nepal by uniting Nepali communities in Norway. Audit Report

Scope of Audit: Financial Statements for the year ended December 31, 2024

The audit was performed to assess the accuracy and completeness of the financial statement of NRNA Norway for the year ended 31. December 2024. The financial statements comprise the balance sheet as at 31.12.2024, income statement for 2024 and notes to the financial statements. We have performed the audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards and practices. This is an informal audit, and undersigned do not bear legal and eventual any other consequences because of this audit.

In our opinion the financial statements are fairly stated and give a true and fair view of the financial position of the of NRNA Norway as at 31.12.2024 and its financial performance.

Our other findings are as follows:

- We have not found formal documentation for income from NRNA membership fees
 - There is not attached letter of grant for Oslo Municipality for grants.
 - There are some significant expenses posts for purchase without documentation
 - There are some significant expenses post for prize money without documentation
 - The overall documentation and bookkeeping from treasurer are found satisfactory

Our recommendation:

Based on our findings, we recommend the following:

- Maintain the list of members and invoice direct for accounting system (Fiken).
 - Attach letter of grants from public institutions
 - Do not process purchase expenses without valid documentation
 - In case of prize, make sure that the documentation contains minimum tournament, team, result/reason and get signature from a preparer and an approver.
